

Marlin Owners Club Data, Privacy and Cookie policies

The Marlin Owners Club (MOC, marlinownersclub.co.uk) provides a website to share advice and enhance the enjoyment of Marlin cars. It is accessible to members and non-members although some sections are available to members only.

The MOC does not share personal information other than in conjunction with running the club. We only collect such information that is necessary or relevant for members to access and use our services. The MOC does not sell any data. The MOC does collect some information in our log files such as page views and ip addresses. The MOC may share personal information with an appropriate authority if required to by law.

Data – GDPR

GDPR (General Data Protection Regulations and the Data Protection Act of 2018).

Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) commitment to the General Data Protection Regulation Statement (GDPR)

The UK General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act of 2018 supersede previous regulations. Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) will comply with applicable GDPR regulations as a data controller.

Here at Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) we take your privacy seriously and will only use your personal information to provide the products and services you have requested from us.

The law on data protection sets out a number of different reasons for which a company may collect and process your personal data.

Consent

On occasions we may wish to share with you information on offers and other promotions via email but only with your specific prior consent, by agreeing to Opt In to any such promotion.

Any such promotions that Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) may run will always offer the facility to unsubscribe so removing you completely from any future promotions.

We at Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) **DO NOT** share your personal information with any other parties, promotion or business other than when order details are to be processed as part of the order fulfilment process.

Privacy whilst purchasing or subscribing online

When you subscribe to the Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) you will need to provide us certain information so that we are able to complete the transaction for you.

If you subscribe or buy something on Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) we will collect contact information (name, address, delivery address, email and phone number) and details of what you bought. We will communicate order information with you primarily via email and occasionally by phone if necessary.

Data collected by this site is used to:

1. Take and fulfil customer orders – such as contact details, delivery details (if different) and the items you have ordered
2. Only disclose your information to third parties for payment (PayPal) and for goods delivery purposes (Carrier)

When You Make A Payment

Your payment information is gathered during checkout portal which is normally operated and secured by PayPal, though payment by GoCardless, BACS or cheque are available options.

PayPal is a 3D-Secure authentication managing the interaction between your card issuing bank and you.

Any cardholder information sent to the banks and any authorisation message coming back is secure and cannot be tampered with, the information remains with the bank. Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) does not have access to this sensitive data.

Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) complies fully with GDPR. That is to say the data must be:

1. Fairly and lawfully processed
2. Processed for limited purposes
3. Adequate, relevant and not excessive
4. Accurate
5. Not kept longer than necessary
6. Processed in accordance with the data subject's rights
7. Secure
8. Not transferred without adequate protection
9. Your data will be remain registered with Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) website for as long as you wish. Upon request we will remove our files, information or any specific item which would identify you uniquely

10. You may at any time email us and ask us to delete your account and related data

Cookie Policy

Like other websites, we use cookies for certain parts of the site.

What is a Cookie and what do they do? A cookie is a small text file stored on your computer by your web browser.

Statistics:

We use Google's analytics to monitor how visitors move around our site and how visitors reached it. This is used so that we can see figures on which types of content visitors use most and how long they stayed. You can opt out of these if you want at: <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout>

Third Party Social Media and other Services Partners

Social networks, video and other services we offer are run by other companies. These companies may drop cookies on your computer when you use them or if you are already logged in to them.

Registration cookies: when you register with one of our services, we generate cookies that let us know whether you are signed in or not. Our servers use these cookies to work out which account you are signed in with, and load specific information relevant to you and your needs.

Anonymous analytics cookies: every time someone visits our website, partner services or software provided by another organisation generates an 'anonymous analytics cookie'. These cookies can tell us whether or not you have visited the site before. Your browser will tell us if you have these cookies and, if you don't, we generate new ones. This allows us to track how many individual users we have, and how often they visit the site. We use these cookies to gather statistics, for example, the number of visits to a page.

Web Server Log and Traffic Analysis

Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) collects IP address data regarding visitors to the web site. The IP address does not reveal any personally identifiable information about the visitor other than the IP address from which they have accessed our site.

Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) may use this information to gather statistics or to initiate future improvements to the site but will NOT share this information with third parties at any time.

Marlin Owners Club (marlinownersclub.co.uk) web servers do not record personally identifiable information about the visitor.

Device information
